<u>Bibles</u>

Requests for Bibles continue to fascinate us! In the last 3 months we have bought 300 Bibles for kids in Uganda; 100 Bibles in the Odia language of India; over 200 Bibles and Gospel of John were shipped to Nigeria. We have provided 3200 Spanish New Testaments for immigrants crossing our borders and another 2000 ordered!



Recently we have provided a request for Bibles in Chinese, Farsi and Arabic for outreach on the campus of Oklahoma State University. And we have provided Bibles in Vietnamese and Marshallese translations at request of Oklahoma prison chaplains!
